### Why should I sign up?

### How does it work?

- The draw takes place every Friday (except for bank holidays);
- Pay by cash, cheque, standing order or card payment;
- Once you join you will be assigned a unique 5 digit Lottery number which we send to you by post;
- Your unique number is then entered in to each draw that you have pre-paid for;
- Winners are chosen by computer at random;
- If you're a winner we automatically post the cash prizes out.

### Who benefits from the Hospice Lottery?

- All our lucky winners - and there are a lot. We give away over 155 cash prizes every year;
- But more importantly, our patients and their families. All proceeds from our Lottery Draw enable us to continue providing care and support to our patients and their families, throughout the Southern Trust Area.
